<b>Year 2:</b> Yellow Class		<b>Painting and mixed media: Life in colour</b> The children will develop colour mixing skills; learning about the work of artist Romare Bearden.		<b>Sculpture and 3D: Clay houses</b> The children will explore the way clay can be shaped and joined; learning about the sculpture of Rachel Whiteread.	<b>Drawing: Tell a story</b> The children will develop their mark-making to explore a wider range of tools; experimenting with creating texture	<b>Craft and design: Woven wonders</b> The children will learn fibre art skills; creating three-dimensional woven artworks inspired by artist Cecilia Vicuña.
<b>Year 3:</b> Green Class	<b>Drawing: Growing artists</b> The children will develop an understanding of shading and drawing techniques; creating botanical inspired drawings.	<b>Painting and mixed media: Prehistoric painting</b> The children will experiment with natural materials; making homemade paints and painting on a range of surfaces.		<b>Craft and design: Fabric</b> The children will create mood boards as inspiration, learning to tie-dye, weaving and sewing to create a range of effects using fabric.		<b>Sculpture and 3D: Abstract shape and space</b> The children will explore how shapes and negative spaces can be represented by three dimensional forms; creating free-standing structures inspired by the work of Anthony Caro.
<b>Year 4:</b> Blue Class	<b>Drawing: Power prints</b> The children will develop an awareness of proportion, composition and pattern in drawing; combining media for effect when developing a drawing into a print.	<b>Painting and mixed media: Light and dark</b> The children will develop skills in colour mixing, focussing on using tints and shades to create a 3D effect; applying painting techniques to a still life piece.		<b>Craft and design: Fabric of nature</b> The children will develop drawings through experimentation and textile-based techniques; designing a repeating pattern suitable for fabric.		<b>Sculpture and 3D: Mega materials</b> The children will explore how different materials can be shaped and joined; learning about techniques used by artists Barbara Hepworth and Sokari Douglas-Camp, children create their own sculptures.
<b>Year 5:</b> Purple Class		<b>Painting and mixed media: Portraits</b> The children will investigate self-portraits by a range of artists; using photographs of themselves to develop their own unique self-portraits in mixed-media.	<b>Drawing: I need space</b> The children will explore the purpose and impact of images from the 'Space race' era of the 1950s and 60s; combining drawing and collagraph printmaking to create a futuristic image.	<b>Sculpture and 3D: Interactive installation</b> The children will learn about the features of installation art and how it can communicate a message; exploring the work of Cai Guo-Qiang	<b>Craft and design: Architecture</b> The children will investigate the built environment through drawing and printmaking; learning about the work of architect Zaha Hadid; creatively presenting research on artist Hundertwasser	
<b>Year 6:</b> Pink Class	<b>Craft and design: Create ancient Egyptian scrolls and sarcophagus</b> The children will develop design and craft skills taking inspiration from Ancient Egyptian art and pattern and paper making.	<b>Sculpture and 3D: Making memories</b> The children will create a personal memory box using a collection of found objects and hand-sculptured forms.	<b>Drawing: Make my voice heard</b> The children will explore imagery, symbols, expressive mark making, and 'chiaroscuro'; creating powerful drawings to make their voices heard.		<b>Craft and design: Photo opportunity</b> The children will develop photography skills and techniques to design a range of creative photographic outcomes.	<b>Painting and mixed media: Artist study</b> The children will explore a selection of paintings; collecting ideas in sketchbooks and planning for a final piece inspired by an artist that interests them.
