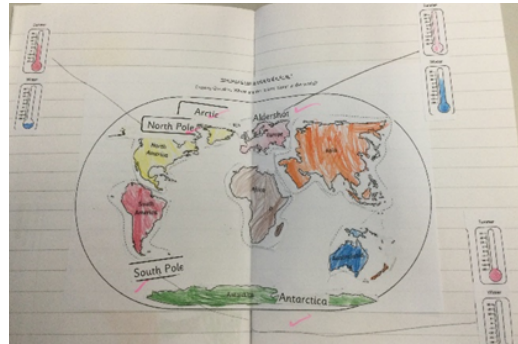

Year 1 Learning Update

This weeks highlights are from Year 1 - Red Class

This week we have been exploring the coldest places in the world as part of our project for the summer term. The children enjoyed creating their own map of the world using atlases, globes and learning 'The Continents Song', which has become a class favourite! We have explored temperature and how it differs depending on the part of the world and season. We used thermometers to explore the temperature of Aldershot and compared it to the North and South Pole. We discovered that Antarctica can reach - 40 °C in the winter!



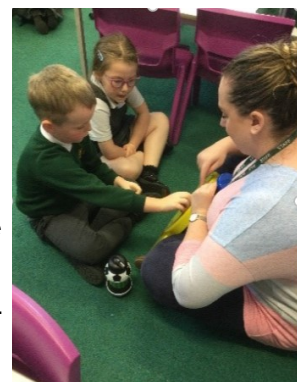
In Literacy we have started writing our own version of Little Red Riding Hood. Some of the children have adapted the story and designed a new character to replace the wolf. The children created some puppets for their story and spent some time in the outdoor area retelling the story. We used lots of story language and enjoyed listening to one another retell the story. The children created a plan for their story and enjoyed sharing their ideas as a class. We have been working hard to show independence in our Literacy lessons, especially to write sentences

by ourselves. We cannot wait to share our stories with our families!

We have had lots of fun learning about time in Maths. We discussed the importance of time and how we use it in our everyday lives. The children enjoyed using the clocks to show time to the hour and half past, giving examples of what may happen at different times of the day. The children have learnt some songs in relation to days of the week and months of the year to help them remember. We also spent some time recapping on our knowledge



of number. We enjoyed representing numbers using different resources: making Numicon sandwiches was our favourite. The children had a competition, working in a group



to order numbers to 100 and showed great teamwork skills. To challenge ourselves we had a look at numbers past 100 and were amazed by the patterns we can see in numbers.
